Privacy Notice

Subscriber Privacy Notice. Customer agrees that AirHOP may from time to time collect and disclose information as described in AirHOP's Privacy Policy (the "Privacy Policy"). The Privacy Policy contains information pertaining to Customer's privacy rights provided under federal law. Customer acknowledges receipt of the Privacy Policy. The Privacy Policy is located on the AirHOP Site and Customer is urged to read the Privacy Policy carefully and in its entirety. AirHOP may, in its sole discretion, change, modify, add, or remove portions of the Privacy Policy, and the Service provided thereunder, at any time. AirHOP will notify Customer of any such changes by posting the modified Privacy Policy on the AirHOP Site, or sending notice via e-mail, postal mail, or other means. Customer's continued use of the Service following notice of such change shall be deemed to be Customer's acceptance of any such modification. If Customer does not agree to any such modification, Customer must immediately stop using the Service and notify AirHOP that Customer is terminating the Privacy Policy and this Agreement. In no event will AirHOP refund service fees.

Collection of Information. Subject to the terms of the Privacy Policy, AirHOP collects, uses, and releases information on Customer use of the Service as necessary to render the Service and to otherwise undertake legitimate business activities related to the Service. Subject to the terms of the Privacy Policy, AirHOP may collect personally identifiable information about Customer preferences which are reflected in the choices that a Customer makes among the range of services offered as part of the Services, the time that the Customer actually uses the Service, the menus and features used most often by the Customer, and other information about a Customer's "electronic browsing."

Use of Information. Federal law permits the collection of information about Customers' use of the Service when it is necessary to provide the Service or to prevent unauthorized access to the Service or to Customer data. Subject to the terms of the Privacy Policy, such Customer information may also be used for other purposes. Collecting information contained in transmissions made by the Customer through the Service directed at the AirHOP Site, other AirHOP Web sites, or other service providers to which access is provided as part of the Service, is necessary to provide the Service.
